FOR YOUR OWN SAFETY AND THE SAFETY OF OTHERS Guidance for families using this Play Area

To ensure you are ready to use this Play Area safely, please read these simple instructions and plan ahead for safe fun this summer.

Parents must read this guidance and ensure their families follow it carefully for the safety of their children and others.

- This equipment is checked regularly for damage, wear and tear, but is not sanitised or disinfected
- 2. This is shared equipment, used at your own risk
- Do not use this equipment if you or any member of your household has coronavirus symptoms or are self-isolating
- 4. Ensure you have hand sanitiser with you before entering the play area
- Encourage everyone in your family to use hand sanitiser regularly and as a minimum before and after using the play area
- Encourage children to avoid touching their faces
- You MUST maintain social distancing from others unless they are from the same household – please ensure you follow the latest government guidance
- Some equipment and in particular multi-play frames should only be used by one child at a time whilst social distancing. Please ensure your family waits at a safe distance if the equipment is in use or return later
- 9. No consumption of food or drink on the play equipment or in the playground area
- 10. Parents/guardians or carers should dispose of all litter including any used protective wear such as face coverings or gloves properly in litter bins (if provided) and taking it home if there is no litter bin available
- 11. Try to avoid busy times
- Wash your hands thoroughly with soap and water for 20 seconds or use hand sanitiser when you return home
